* Farmer/ Producer has to take good care of goats by giving them proper feed/ water, etc at his own cost.

* It is for sure that these ## female goats will multiply and give birth to the new kid goats in couple of months from the day of farmer's receipt.

* The new born goats have to be fed well & care should be taken for at least six months before selling to the company.

* Farmer/ Producer has to have shed sufficient for ## goats. Farmer/ Producer has to maintain the farm/shed in very neat & clean manner (In & out of farm/shed).

* Farmer/ Producer has to be in touch with local veterinary doctors for any suggestions, guidelines & for better healthy growth.
