Technique: Low cut tufting done in blue color on one side and printed fabric braids

used as chord on the other to fill up the semicircle.

Edging: Knife Edge.



Base fabric: Cotton Slub (H)

Technique: This cushion is made using dyable cotton slub base and dyable yarns of different densities to highlight the pattern ,then it is dyed and stone washed to give it a monotone effective.

Edging: Knife Edge with 4 corner tassels

Base fabric: Oatmeal

Technique: Tufted with blue yarn on half diamond and the base and then half diamond is filled using tie dyed Buckley yarn. The geometric grid is formed by using braded blue white
